



## Southwest Conference of Mayors

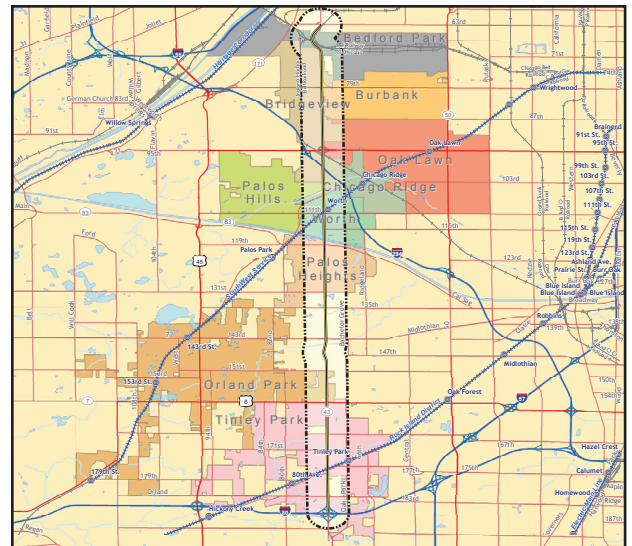
The Southwest Conference of Mayors (SCM) is comprised of the Chief Elected Officials from twenty-one communities in southwest suburban Cook County.
